24/7 evacuation helpline for Ukrainians



ABOUT HELPING TO LEAVE



The project was launched on February 24 – the day Russia invaded Ukraine. It was created by a multinational team of people with experience in activism, media and art. Over the first few weeks of the war, the project's team built a volunteer base and created an efficient technological infrastructure that helps Ukrainians evacuate from the war zone and receive much needed financial aid.

HOW IT WORKS

Volunteer operators are online 24/7 to consult and coordinate people who need help throughout the process of evacuation.

The team solves even the most difficult tasks, and offers expense coverage, psychological help and informational support.

Help is offered not only to those in Ukraine, but also to those in the occupied territories and those who found themselves in Russia since the war began.

WHAT WE'VE DONE

> **10,000** evacuation requests completed
(usually there are 2 or more people behind each application)

> **1,500** fact-checked instructional posts on leaving war zones in Ukraine in the project's Telegram channel

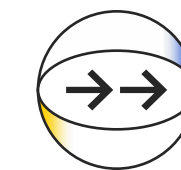
> **2,500** individual consultations provided by the Telegram channel's admin

> **€80,000** worth of financial aid delivered to over 2,000 Ukrainians
